

2019 William Freiburger Scholarship Application

The William Freiburger Scholarship has been established by the Batavia Tennis Team and those who loved William. William passed away unexpectedly due to a cerebral aneurysm on February 20, 2018, during his Senior year at Batavia High School. William would have graduated with his classmates in May 2018, and this scholarship was first awarded starting with his graduating class. The scholarship is designed to honor college bound graduating seniors on the Batavia tennis team who embodied William's love for others and serving in his community. William was an involved student who served in his community and globally to help others in need. He influenced many young lives and had a passion to help and live each day to the full.

For the students graduating in May 2019, there will be one \$1000 scholarship awarded. The award shall be paid directly to the school the recipients will be attending and is non-renewable. The school may be a college, university, community college, trade or vocational school, or a professional school.

Qualifications The recipients must be graduating Batavia High School seniors who not only fit the criteria outlined above, but who submit a completed application by the due date. Applications can be dropped off or mailed to the Batavia High School Counseling & Advising Department, 1200 West Wilson Street, Batavia, Illinois, 60510. The completed scholarship application must be received in the Counseling Department no later than **March 1, 2019 at 4pm.**

Scholarship Requirements

1. The applicant must be a graduating senior attending Batavia High School on the Batavia Tennis Team
2. The applicant should be involved in an Extracurricular Club at Batavia High School that serves in the Community in numerous ways and globally as well.
3. Applications must submit an essay that accompanies their application. Specific instructions for the essay can be found on the application sheet. Application materials will not be returned to the applicants.
4. Awards will not be based on financial need.
5. The selection committee for the scholarship shall consist of the Freiburger Family and Batavia Tennis Coaches.
6. The Batavia Tennis Team and family reserves the right to amend or terminate the scholarship program at any time. The scholarships may be withheld or suspended in any one or more years at discretion. All decisions in regards to this scholarship will be final.
